From a total of **2,012,390** families:

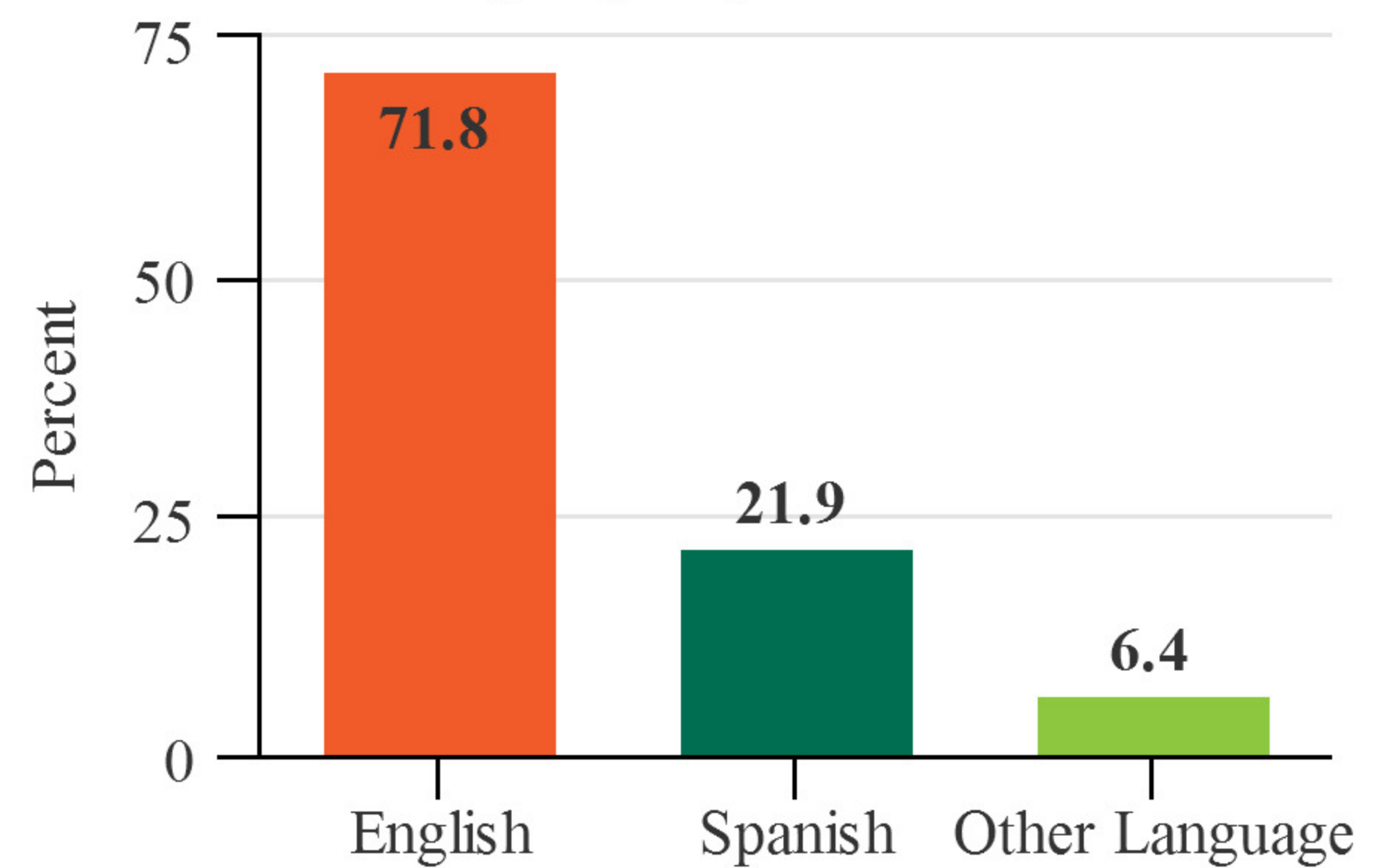


**783,163 (38.9%)** are headed by single parents
